Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) Course
March 03, 2022 – June 08, 2022, Weaverville, California

Course Description

- EMT is an intensive course designed to give students the ability to develop decision making strategies and function as a part of a team, applying skills learned to provide emergency pre-hospital care to the sick and injured
- Course is 190 hours of varied assignments and classroom activities including lecture/discussion, skills, interactive scenarios, testing, and clinical shifts at TCLS Weaverville, AMR Redding, and Trinity Hospital Weaverville

Pre-Requisites

- Current BLS CPR Certification
- Proof of Immunizations (see Immunization attachment)
- Students must be 17 1/2 years of age (see EMT Certification attachment)
- Physical fitness adequate to lift and move patients, utilize tools and equipment safely

Course Schedule

- Class meets weekly on Wednesday & Thursday 5:00pm – 10:00pm
One-hour lunch break. Bring snacks, if needed
- Begins Wednesday, March 03, 2022 through Saturday, June 11, 2022.
- Snow days may occur for student safety, affecting course dates. Major holidays and Spring Break off.

Course Dress Code (see Uniform/Textbook attachment)

- Uniform shirt and photo ID (provided by EMT Program)
- Navy blue or black pants, suitable for EMS wear and shifts (responsibility of student)
- Boots suitable for uneven ground, auto extrication (responsibility of student)
- Uniform is worn for class and clinical time, clean and presentable, shirt tucked in, belt

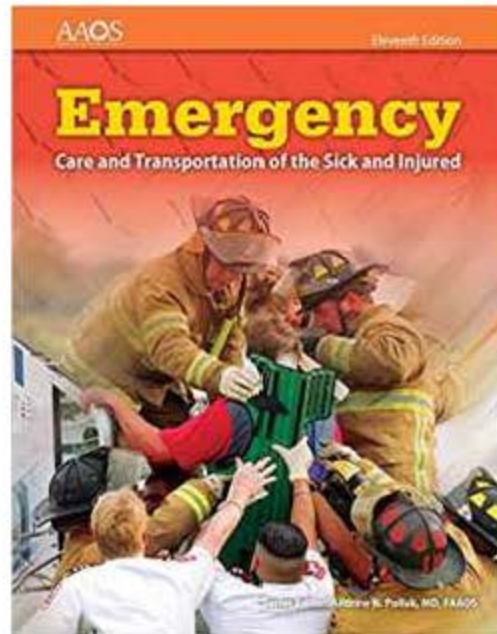
